State Convention and Salina Lodging

The Kansas Square Dance Convention is June 5 and 6. It’s always a lot of fun – there are workshops, a fashion show, clogging demonstrations, shopping opportunities, and lots & lots of dancing at all levels. The Convention is in Salina at the Bicentennial Center.

Lodging. At past conventions HTS members have stayed at the same place, enjoying camaraderie between sessions and enjoying ice cream after the last evening dance. This year we are staying at the Super 8. We had sent this information earlier; but there are a few rooms remaining, so we will send it again.

Here is more information:

The I-70 Super 8 Motel is just off I-70 at Exit 252. It is about 10 minutes from the Bicentennial Center. The rate for a room is \$61.09/night + tax. With tax, the amount is \$68.46. There are six rooms remaining, each with two queen size beds. They are nonsmoking rooms.

The number of people in a room does not change the price. So more than two people may stay in the room at the same rate.

Super 8 has the following amenities:

- Indoor pool and hot tub (open until 11:00 p.m.)
- Free high speed Internet
- Hair dryers in rooms
- Irons/ironing boards available upon request

There is a Continental breakfast (oatmeal, cereal, fruit, pastries, toast and English muffins). For those wanting a heartier breakfast, there is a McDonald's within walking distance and an I-Hop and Grandma Max's nearby.

We will be able to gather in the lobby/breakfast area for ice cream after a day of Convention dancing. While the area is not as roomy as we like, we will be able to spill outside if necessary (entry has a covered portico).

If you are interested in staying at the Super 8, Call the Super 8 motel at 785-823-8808 and tell the desk clerk you are with Happy Time Squares. Be sure you call the I-70 motel – there are two Super 8 Motels in Salina. Also specify what nights you will be there.

Specify what **kind of room** you want, **what nights you will be there**, if you want nonsmoking, and whether you want a first floor room (there are no elevators). For those of you who plan to arrive on June 4, the same rate will apply.

Be sure to confirm the rate on your room. You should also get a **reservation confirmation number**. The best way to secure your reservation is with a credit card. **Super 8 has a very generous cancellation policy.** You may cancel up until 6:00 p.m. on the day you are scheduled to arrive.
