#### **MEET THE 2012 HASSDA FESTIVAL CALLERS**

<u>Jeff Holley</u> comes from a family of Square Dance Callers. Both his father and brother blazed a path before him in square dance calling. Jeff would rush home after school and practice calling and singing. His father's club was having lessons when after much pestering by Jeff, he relented and let Jeff call a patter call and then a singing call. Jeff was so nervous he did not look at the dancers; and after he would call promenade, he did not use any fill in lyrics - going directly to the next figure. He was calling so fast the dancers had to run to keep up! After his singing call, he was having so much fun he wouldn't stop...his father finally walked on stage and unplugged his equipment to make him quit. Some 20+ years later a dancer that had been on the floor that infamous night reminded Jeff of his first calling experience.

Jeff and his wife Nancy have five children and own Hometown Foods in Crescent, OK. Jeff recalled a time when he was booked for an out-of-town dance. Like most callers, he kept his equipment in his truck but had taken it into the house to practice some new songs for this particular dance. While reloading the equipment, one of the children needed help with something. After helping the child, he loaded the family in the truck. As he was pulling into the dance, he realized he had forgotten to finish loading the calling equipment - every caller's nightmare! Luckily, the people that hired him had a turntable and some records and the dance went on as scheduled.

Many of you may remember Jeff from the 2004 and 2005 HASSDA Festivals in Muskogee, OK, where he was one of our featured callers. Jeff says he loves to teach, whether it is brand new dancers or something new to seasoned dancers.

Jeff currently calls for three clubs in the OKC area: Spirit of 76, Single Squares, and the Okie Diamonds, which is a plus club.

<u>Bobby Willis</u> comes with a list of credentials for square dance calling, but we would rather share some of the colorful events in his career.

Very early in Bobby's calling career he was hired by the Singles to call a Pajama Dance in Enid, OK. A "support group of dancers" from his home area went with him. Being "supportive dancers," they decided to break him in and plotted to pull a prank on him. After the Grand March, they positioned themselves in the front square; and when he started to call, they all sat down and played a game of Jacks!

Bobby recalled when he used to fill in for Jerry Linduff at Silver Dollar Squares. One night he was filling in for Jerry and was on-stage calling a tip when in walked two Oklahoma City Police Officers. They proceeded to walk on-stage and handcuffed him to haul him off to jail. "I was told I was being arrested for 'impersonating a professional square dance caller". Fortunately neither the judge nor jury knew what a "square dance caller" was supposed to do; and, therefore. all charges were dismissed and the dance continued. "Until I realized I had been set up, I was more than a little concerned!" It turned out one of the couples had a daughter that was an OKC police officer.
